Love and Logic Magic When Kids Leave You Speechless

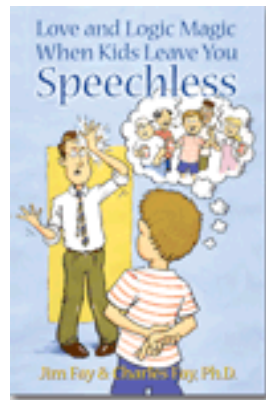
Great comebacks every parent needs. Jim Fay and Charles Fay, Ph.D., have put together a book that will give you the actual words.

From toddler to teens, you'll find yourself ready for this book when your kids say things like:

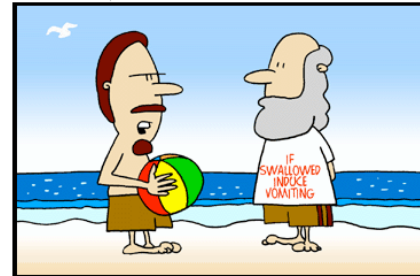
