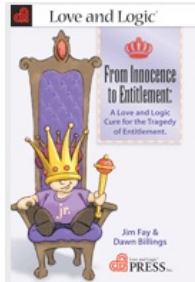
Book Report - Our next report which is to be a mystery is being moved to Wednesday, November 25. Remember the book needs to be read by that date.

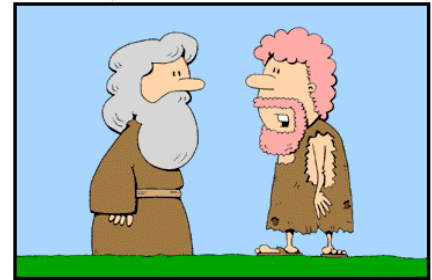
