Reminders: Why They Aren't Always a Good Thing

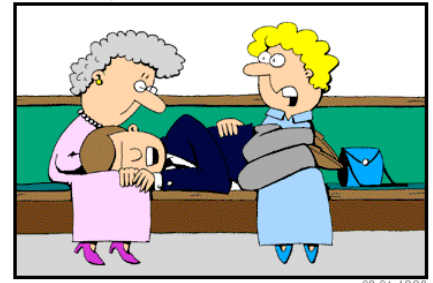
