





GOSPEL LESSON

John 4:46-54

46 Jesus came again to Cana in Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine. In Capernaum, there was a certain royal official whose son was sick. 47 When this man heard that Jesus had come from Judea into Galilee, he went to him and begged him to come down and heal his son, because his son was about to die. 48 Jesus told him, "Unless you people see miraculous signs and wonders, you certainly will not believe." 49 The royal official said to him, "Lord, come down before my little boy dies." 50 "Go," Jesus told him, "your son is going to live."

The man believed this word that Jesus spoke to him and left. 51 Already as he was going down, his servants met him with the news that his boy was going to live. 52 So he asked them what time his son got better. THE NICENE CREED


I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.




