





FIRST LESSON

Isaiah 40:1-8

Comfort, comfort my people, says your God. 2 Speak to the heart of Jerusalem and call out to her. Her warfare really is over. Her guilt is fully paid for. Yes, she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins. 3 A voice is calling out: "In the wilderness, prepare the way for the LORD. Make level in the desert a highway for our God. 4 Let every valley be lifted up, and every mountain and hill made low. The crooked ground will become level, and the rough places will become a plain. 5 Then the glory of the LORD will be revealed, and all flesh together shall see it." Truly, the LORD's mouth has spoken. 6 A voice is saying, "Call out!" And I said, "What shall I call out?" "All flesh is grass, and all its beauty is like a flower in the field. 7 Grass withers, flowers fade, when the breath of the LORD blows upon them. Surely the people are grass. 8 Grass withers, flowers fade, but the Word of our God endures forever." 9 Get up on a high mountain, O Zion, you herald of good news. Lift up your voice with strength, O Jerusalem, you herald of good news. Lift it up! Do not be afraid! Say to the

cities of Judah, "Behold your God!" 10 Look, God the LORD will come with strength, and his arm is ruling for him. Look, his reward is with him. His recompense is before him. 11 Like a shepherd he will tend his flock. With his arm he will gather the lambs. He will lift them up into his lap. He will lead the nursing mothers gently. (EHV)


SECOND LESSON

1 Corinthians 4:1-5

This is the way a person should think of us: as servants of Christ and stewards of God's mysteries. 2 In this connection, moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful. 3 But it is a trivial matter to me if I am evaluated by you or by a day in a human court. Why, I do not even evaluate myself. 4 I do not in fact know of anything against myself, but I am not justified by this; rather, the one who evaluates me is the Lord. 5 Therefore judge nothing ahead of time, until the Lord comes. He will bring to light whatever is hidden in darkness and also reveal the intentions of hearts. Then there will be praise for each person from God. (EHV)

Matthew 11:2-10

2 While John was in prison, he heard about the things Christ was doing. He sent two of his disciples 3 to ask him, "Are you the Coming One or should we wait for someone else?" 4 Jesus answered them, "Go, report to John what you hear and see: 5 The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the gospel is preached to the poor. 6 Blessed is the one who does not take offense at me." 7 As these two were leaving, Jesus began to talk to the crowds about John. "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken by the wind? 8 What did you go out to see? A man dressed in soft clothing? No, those who wear soft clothing are in kings' houses. 9 So what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I tell you! THE NICENE CREED
