

FIRST LESSON Proverbs 4:10-23

10Listen, my son, and accept my words, so that the years of your life will be many. 11I have instructed you in the way of wisdom. I have led you along straight paths. 12When you walk, your stride will not be hindered. Even if you run, you will not stumble. 13Hold on to discipline. Do not let go. Guard it, because it is your life. 14Do not travel on the path of the wicked. Do not walk in the way of evil people. 15Avoid it! Do not travel on it! Turn away from it. Pass it by. 16For they cannot sleep unless they have been doing wrong, and they are robbed of sleep unless they are making someone stumble, 17because wickedness is the food they eat, and violence is the wine they drink. 18But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, shining brighter and brighter until it is day. 19The way of the wicked is like gloomy darkness. SECOND LESSON Galatians 5:16-24

16What I am saying is this: Walk by the spirit, and you will not carry out what the sinful flesh desires. 17For the sinful flesh desires what is contrary to the spirit, and the spirit what is contrary to the sinful flesh. In fact, these two continually oppose one another, so that you do not continue to do these things you want to do. 18But if you are led by the spirit, you are not under the control of the law. 19Now the works of the

WORDS OF INSTITUTION
