2020! A donation made to ACSTO before you file your 2020 taxes will serve as a 2020 Arizona tax credit! Don't forget to name Emmaus Lutheran as the recipient school, and you may also name a specific student as a recipient, as long as the student is not your own dependent.

DO YOU OWE STATE TAX? Check

Line 48 of 2018 AZ Tax Form 140 to find out! The figure that appears on Line 48 is the amount of your tax liability.

HOW MUCH CAN YOU DONATE? The cap for AZ Tuition Tax Credit donations for private schools is \$2269 (married) or \$1135 (single).
