<u>Health/Absence Reminder</u> – If your child is sick, please let the office know in the morning. You can either email at <u>office@emmauslutheran.com</u> or call 602-843-3853.

Also, your child must be <u>fever-free for</u> <u>24 hours</u> before returning to school. The same policy applies to **diarrhea** and vomiting.
