

Early Dismissal and No School – On Wednesday, November 21st, the entire school will be dismissed at noon. There will be **NO EXTENDED CARE** in the afternoon. Thursday and Friday, November 22 & 23, there will be no school in observance of Thanksgiving.

Children's Christmas Services –

On Sunday, December 9th, we will be having one Sunday worship service at 9:00 am during which the Preschool, PreK, Kindergarten and 1st grade children will be singing and saying recitations. There will be breakfast and fellowship following this service in the Fellowship Hall.
