TADS Enrollment – If you indicated that your child will be returning to Emmaus for the 2019-2020 school year, you should have received an email. This email is to set up your TADS tuition account. Billing for Kindergarten – 8th grade is done over 12 months, June – May, unless you request otherwise. Your account must be setup by <u>June 1st</u> If you have any questions, please contact the office.

Last Day of School - is Thursday, May 23rd. This will be a *HALF* day of school with Kindergarten – 8th grade being dismissed at 12:15 pm. Children in Preschool and PreK will be dismissed at 11:10 am. At 11:15 am, all families are invited to join with your child for a picnic lunch. Emmaus will be providing sub sandwiches, chips and drinks. After lunch, we will all meet in the church for our closing chapel service. After chapel Preschool and PreK will be dismissed. Kindergarten through grade 8 will go back to their classrooms to receive their report cards and then they will be dismissed. Students in K – 8th grade are expected to stay until they are released after chapel. All students need to be picked up by 12:15 pm. There will be no Extended Care after dismissal.

<u>VBS</u> – Vacation Bible School will be held at Emmaus June 3 – 5 from 6-8 pm. This year's VBS is called "Roadtrip". VBS is for preschool age children through 6th grade. We will have bible stories, crafts, games, music, and snacks. And it is all free!
