

All School News

<u>Welcome Back</u> - We rejoice that God has blessed our school with an enrollment of 74 students this year. Thank you for having your children at Emmaus. Let's make it a great year!

Early Release Fridays – Every Friday, students in grades K-8 will be **dismissed at 1:45 pm**. Any students remaining at 2:00 pm will be walked to Extended Care. There is an hourly charge for using Extended Care.

Early Release Fridays will be used by the staff to have Bible Study, faculty meetings, and meetings with parents.

Parking Lot Safety - You should have received a map showing morning dropoff and afternoon pickup procedures. We ask that only Emmaus Staff park in the parking lot to the north of the church, that runs along Sweetwater Ave. This is also the "Morning Drop-Off Only" - enter east driveway of Sweetwater, exit west driveway of Sweetwater. If it is going to take a few minutes for your child to gather their things, you need to speak with a teacher or if you need to sign your child in or out (Preschool, Prek, K) please park in a space in the parking lot to drop off and pick up your child. If you enter from Sweetwater Ave, pull into a parking spot, then exit onto 39th Ave. If you enter from 39th Ave, turn by the green recycle bins and pull into a parking spot. Exit onto Sweetwater Ave. We hope that by following these guidelines we can keep our children safe. If you did not receive a map, please stop by the office for a copy.

<u>Music Lessons</u> - Band lessons are being offered by Mrs. Amy Unkefer for grades 4-8. Piano lessons are being offered by Mrs. Marilyn Feliciano for grades 2-8. Please stop by the office for more information or to sign up.

Student Arrival & Pick Up - For the safety of our students the gate into the school courtyard will be locked at 8:30 am and remain locked until classes are dismissed. Preschool and PreK students will be walked to this gate at noon, where they can be then be picked up. Grades K – 8 are dismissed at 3:15 pm, Monday – Thursday and 1:45 pm on Friday, and will walk out to the north wall of the Fellowship Hall with their teacher where they can be picked up. Parents are asked to wait outside until the gate is opened. If you need to pick up a child from Extended Care between noon and 3:15 pm. please come through the office and exit the same way.

It would be great to have your child in their classroom no later than 8:20 am so they have time to unpack and be ready for devotion at 8:30 am.

Dress Code - Students in 5th-8th grade may not wear tank tops without a sleeved-shirt underneath or another top over that covers the shoulders. Shirts, blouses, and tops must meet the pants, shorts, or skirts. Bare midriffs, seethrough shirts, and "spaghetti" straps are not permitted. Shorts may be worn, but they must reach the child's fingertips or longer. Cut-off shorts or short shorts are not to be worn. Girls may wear skirts or a dress, but they must reach the child's fingertips or longer. They are encouraged to wear shorts underneath. Shoes must have a closed-toe and be secured to their feet. For your child's safety, flip-flops can be worn on special days (e.g. Flip-Flop Fridays). It would still be wise to bring along a pair of tennis shoes for recess. Clothing that is sarcastic or doesn't send a positive message is not permitted.

We rely on you, the parents, to make sure your child is properly dressed for the school day. **Chapel** - Our Chapel service will be held on Fridays at 8:30 am. Parents are encouraged to join us if it works into your schedule. Mission envelopes are sent home every Thursday for chapel on Friday. Please help teach your child that it's not the amount that you give in chapel that is most important; it's a way for them to say thanks to God for all the things He has given us. The students will be picking their Mission Projects next week.

Please join us for worship - Our

weekly church services are on Sunday at 8:00 and 10:30 AM, with Bible Study for children, teens and adults at 9:15 AM. We'd love to worship with you!
