

Financial Aid - Forms for the Emmaus Financial Aid Fund are available in the school office or under today's Chronicle on the Emmaus website. If you would like to apply for financial aid for the first period, (September, October, and November) please fill out a form and write a letter to the Board of Education explaining your financial need. This paper work can be turned in to Mrs. Conklin in the school office. The deadline for the first quarter financial aid is Friday, Aug. 31st.

Fry's – Please link your Fry's VIP card to Emmaus for the Fry's Community Partners Program. Go to Frysfood.com to sign up. Our school is NPO # is BW447.
