Financial Aid - Forms for the Emmaus Financial Aid Fund are available in the school office or under today's Chronicle on the Emmaus website. This paper work can be turned in to Mrs. Conklin in the school office. The deadline for the first quarter financial aid is *Friday, Sept. 1*<sup>st</sup>.
