**No School** – on Monday, September 7<sup>th</sup> in observance of Labor Day.

**Student Arrival** – Just a reminder *parents of students in K-8 are asked to say goodbye to their child at the gate.* We currently have a closed campus for the health and safety of the students and staff. For this reason, we are trying to limit how many people are on the school campus.

**Spirit Days** – Our 1<sup>st</sup> Spirit Day is this Wednesday, 8/26, and it is Neon/Tie-dye day. Students should wear clothing that is either neon or tie-dyed. Let's show our school spirit!

Every month we will have 1 or 2 "Spirit Days". On these days students are asked to dress in a specific way to show their school spirit. Each time a student participates in a Spirit Day, they will be entered into a raffle drawing for that month. The winner will receive a \$5 McDonald's gift card.

**Dress Code** - Students in 5th-8th grade may not wear tank tops without a sleeved-shirt underneath or another top over that covers the shoulders. Shirts, blouses, and tops must meet the pants, shorts, or skirts. Bare midriffs, see-through shirts, and "spaghetti" straps are not permitted. Shorts may be worn, but they must reach the child's fingertips or longer. Cut-off shorts or short shorts are not to be worn. Girls may wear skirts or a dress, but they must reach the child's fingertips or longer. They are encouraged to wear shorts underneath. Shoes must have a closed-toe and be secured to their feet. For your child's safety, flip-flops can be worn on special days (e.g. Flip-Flop Fridays). It would still be wise to bring along a pair of tennis shoes for recess. Clothing that is sarcastic or doesn't send a positive message is not permitted.

We rely on you, the parents, to make sure your child is properly dressed for the school day.

**Chapel** - Our Chapel service will be held on Fridays at 8:30 am. Parents are encouraged to join us if it works into your schedule. Mission envelopes are sent home every Thursday for chapel on Friday. Please help teach your child that it's not the amount that you give in chapel that is most important; it's a way for them to say thanks to God for all the things He has given us. Our first mission project will be announced soon. Our offerings so far are \$24.80.
