- Tournament (at ALA) March 2 <sup>nd</sup> -4 <sup>th</sup> * (Probability to switch to all day March 3 <sup>rd</sup> &
4 <sup>th</sup> ) See discussion note below.
d. B Team Jamboree (at ALA) – Date is February 4 <sup>th</sup> *Tentative date*
(Motion made & passed to inquire with ALA about the Jamboree being held on Feb. 25 <sup>th</sup> )
e. Track Meet – date is April 8 <sup>th</sup> ?, 22 <sup>nd</sup> , or 29 <sup>th</sup> ? (Mark Kaiser will keep in contact with
GCC.); 22 <sup>nd</sup> is the preferred choice by the league.

\*Reminder\*: Schools should schedule all games with Peridot separately, contact Chris Mundstock. Peridot is only able to play on Fridays & Saturdays.

## **Discussion Items**

1. Executive committee make the brackets for ALL tournaments. Host schools handle all other aspects for running a tournament (fields, refs, trophies, concession stand)

(Motion made & passed to have executive committee to create ALL brackets for ALL tournaments throughout the year...host schools will still handle all other duties)

2. BB League Tournament – Idea to move to ALL day Friday and Saturday tournament instead of ½ Thurs, 1/2 Friday, & all day Sat.

League liked the idea of doing ALL day Fri. & Sat...will have to discuss with ALA & Valley. Mark Kaiser will approach the host schools before we set this in stone. \*

3. BB - After 5<sup>th</sup> foul player may remain on the court but any foul after the 5<sup>th</sup> will result in a 2 shot technical and ball possession for the other team.

## League discussed & dismissed this.

- 4. BB Should we try to schedule more weekend games? Small round-robins?
- Discussion made to survey parents about feedback on Saturday games (google forms completed by Chris Mundstock). Discussion also made about schools who want to do this can get together & plan separately based on the schedule that Stefan/executive committee make in November.
- 5. Information on any upcoming league tournaments must be out a week before the tournament (to help our parents plan). (Executive Committee)
  What if there are games that still must be played? Not counted towards seeding?
  (winter meeting minutes) Stefan/executive committee will attempt to leave a week open before the tournament so make-up games can be completed before seeding.
- 6. Issues NOT covered from the Winter AD meeting (because your chairman dropped the ball)
- a. Can the FB rules/penalties be simplified? Committee of a few AD's/coaches will meet to simplify rules to come up with proposed simplified rule book for Summer Mtg. An email will come out from Mark asking for volunteers to be on committee. They will meet in Spring after Track season. This never occurred (Mark ②)...Tommy Stelter will make any changes to rule-book, update, etc...(Will conference with Mark Kaiser)
  - b. Study the whole year's sports season schedule and evaluate its practicality. Why are

sports seasons where they are? Look at all the sports we offer and evaluate them i.e. - Is softball the best sport to be offering our girls? What can we do better? Anything not working well?

(Motion raised & passed to raise to overall league fee to \$225 & each individual sport fee (for those paying separately by sport) an additional \$5. League fee to be paid by September 1<sup>st</sup>.)

Tommy Stelter will look into purchasing t-shirts for the "Henderson memorial" tournament. Each school will donate a set amount of money. (TBD)
